If you have ever scribbled ideas onto a piece of paper and drawn lines between related thoughts, then you already know what Scapple does. It's a virtual sheet of paper that lets you make notes anywhere on the page and connect them using lines and arrows.

You can move notes around and customise their appearance using colours and borders. Connecting notes is as easy as dragging one note onto another. Scapple is an incredibly simple but powerful way of shaping your ideas.
